

## Rules and Conditions for **visitors playing or watching** squash and racquetball at Mulgrave Country Club, updated on 12th February 2021

**\*ONLY SYMPTOM FREE PATRONS AND STAFF WILL BE PERMITTED TO ENTER SQUASH AND RACQUETBALL CENTRE\***

All state and federal government restrictions are to be adhered to at all times

### **Attendance:**

- **ALL players and visitors must register and sign in and out at Reception via main entrance** before entering and exiting the courts as per Government guidelines. By signing in, each visitor agrees to the facility terms and conditions and always demonstrating best practice social distancing on court
- Court attendance will be retained by the Club's Centre Management in the event Government contact tracing is required
- Players are permitted to go into other areas of Mulgrave CC in in line with Club rules

### **Hygiene:**

- **The wearing of Masks is required within facility at all times except when playing a match, eating or drinking**
- Players and visitors must sanitise hands on entry and exit to the facility and entry and exit to the courts, sanitiser and cleaning equipment will be provided. **All Players and visitors to undertake contactless temperature check in the foyer before entering the court area.**
- There will be no wiping of hands on side walls or glass back of court, any coughing or sneezing should be into a towel or elbow of arm, no shaking hands with anyone
- Players to bring a towel to wipe any excess sweat they create during the session
- Players to supply their own racquets for the session, there is to be no sharing of equipment amongst courts
- Players are required to bring their own bottled water for rehydration, access to refill water bottles will be available at the water cooler
- **Court door handles and glass wall are to be sanitized or disinfected following each session by those players before allowing the next booking players on the court**
- The toilet, showers and change rooms are accessible with maximum numbers displayed on restroom doors. Steam room remains closed

### **Court Play:**

- A maximum of 4 people per court will be allowed. Hence, with 4 courts, a maximum of 16 people can be across all 4 courts at any one time with a total of 20 in the court area itself.
- A maximum of 20 players / spectators allowed in the upstairs gallery
- Players to maintain physical distancing of 1.5 metres as per guidelines
